The Austin 7 Club of SA is hosting Austins Over Australia 2019 in the picturesque Barossa Valley. It will run from Monday September 23 to Friday September 27 2019.

The renowned Bay to Birdwood Classic for “original” vehicles built on or after 1st January 1956 and on or before 31st December 1981 will be held on the Sunday after the event (Sept 29). It is the biggest continuous held motoring event for Classic vehicles in the world. Entries for this event fill fast & close when 1750 have been received (usually before the nominated closing date). If your nominated AOA 2019 vehicle fits the criteria, you will be sent an entry form when they become available. If you don't have an eligible vehicle, or don't want to be an entrant in the event, you can still watch from the side of the road like thousands of others. If you haven't seen, or been an entrant in the event before, it is worthwhile taking the time to be an observer on the day.

The planned itinerary for AOA 2019 is on the next page.

Attached is an ENTRY FORM for AOA 2019 which must be completed & returned to the Treasurer along with your payment **BY NO LATER THAN JUNE 30th 2019** – details are on the entry form.

No entry fee is applicable if a second vehicle is entered, as long as both cars are driven by an immediate family member, however, a separate entry form must be submitted for each car, with no entry fee payable on the second one.

Rally Headquarters will be located at **Chateau Tanunda, 9 Basedow Road, Tanunda**. The Chateau is a working winery with its own Cellar Door. Tastings of their range of wines will be available during Registration, as will tea & coffee. There may be a bit of a walk from your car to the door of the Chateau, however there will be some close parking for those who tick the Disability Parking Permit box on the entry form & display the Permit each time they arrive at the Chateau.

A prepaid self serve cereal, toast and cooked breakfast will be available at the Rally Headquarters each morning, Tues to Fri.- see entry form

Rocker Cover races will be held each morning, Tuesday to Friday, so either dust off your old rocker covers or prepare a new one for this prestigious event. If you plan to be a participant in this event, please mark the appropriate box on the attached Entry Form. If, after you have submitted your entry form, you decide to enter, please let me know by no later than end July 2019. All Rocker Covers must be presented for Scrutineering at Monday afternoons Registration. A great group photo opportunity of all Austins attending will be provided at the National Motor Museum on the Tuesday.

On the Wednesday, there will be a Funkhana at the Kapunda Harness Racing track. It should be lots of fun for those who are involved and even more fun for the remaining entrants who will be cheering on their State representatives. 2 participants per State or Territory will be required for this activity. Each vehicle must have a roof and an able-bodied passenger. If you and your passenger are prepared to be a participant in this event, please mark the appropriate box on the attached Entry Form. The event organiser will choose the participants if there is more than 2 from any state.

The Farewell dinner is also being held at Chateau Tanunda. It will have an **Aussie Outback theme**, so come prepared – let your imagination run wild.

It is recognised that there will be some entrants who won't be driving an Austin. Some of them will be assisting with the running of the rally in some form or another whilst others may be "Swaggies". Their vehicles will not be included in the group photo at the National Motor Museum nor will they be permitted on the reserve in Mannum or the Kapunda Trotting track. They will be provided suitable alternative parking.

Please remember to **bring a foldable chair** to sit on, at least during off site lunch breaks.
